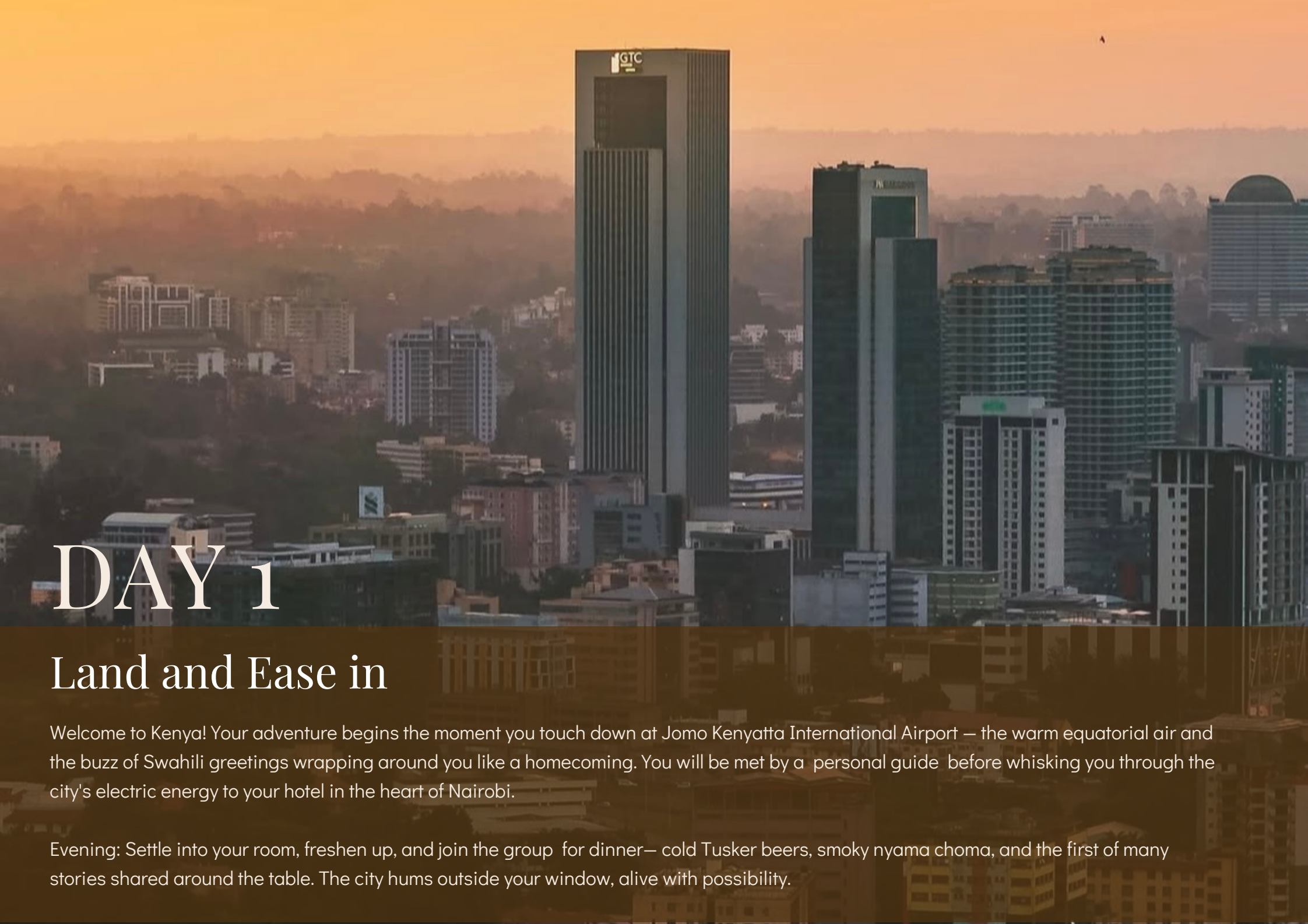

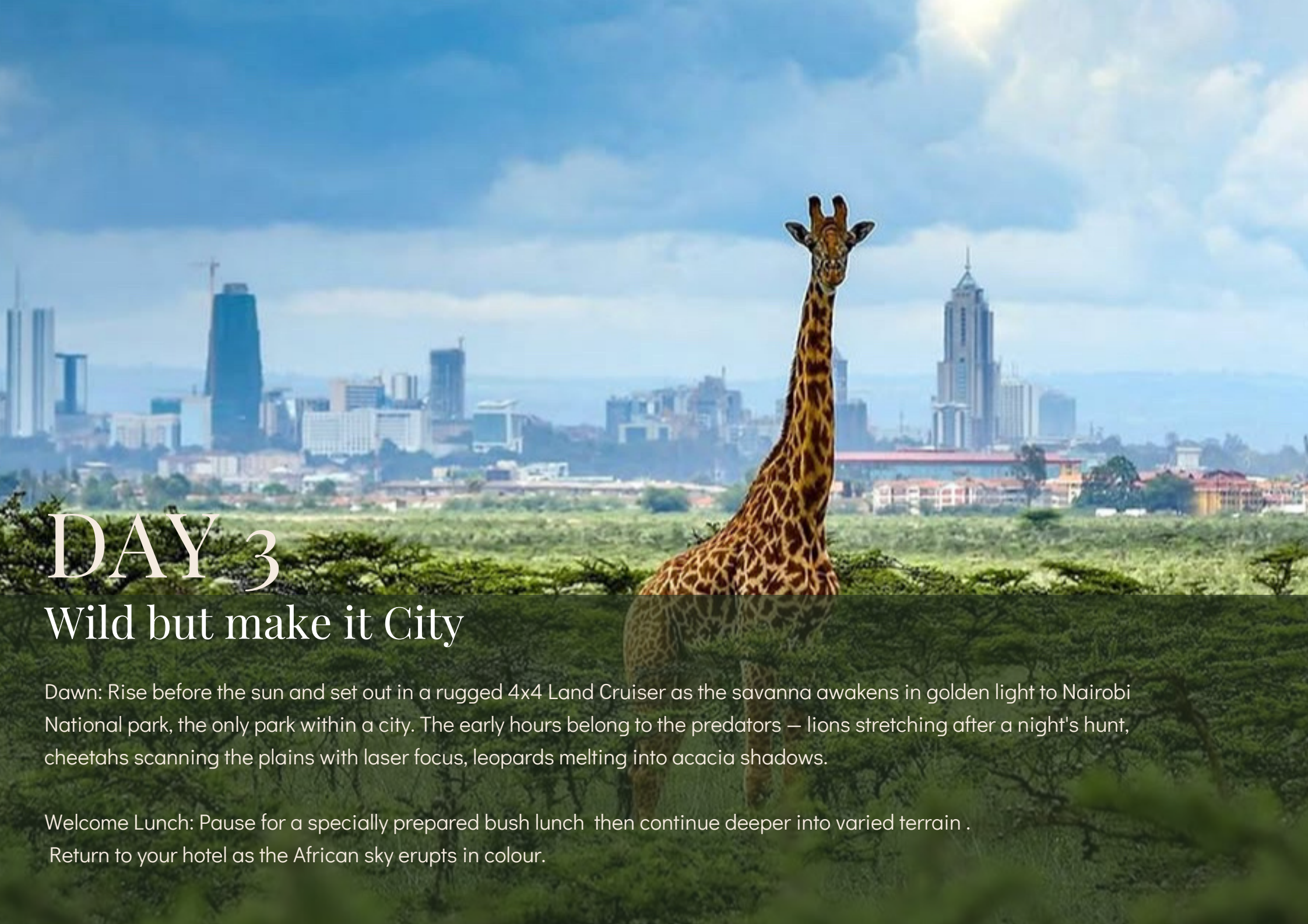
DAY 2

DAY 3

Wild but make it City

DAY 5

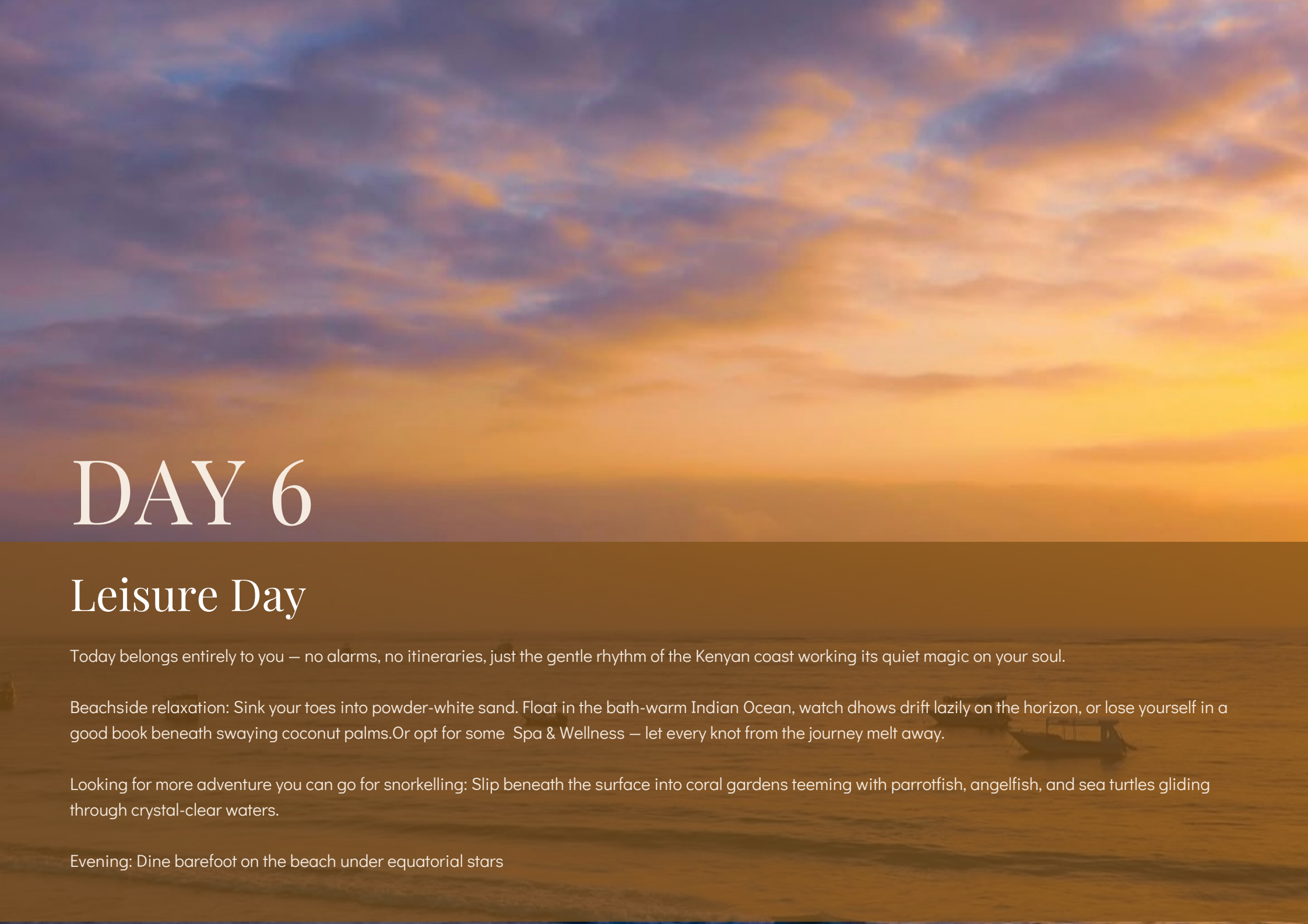
Malindi Tour

DAY 7

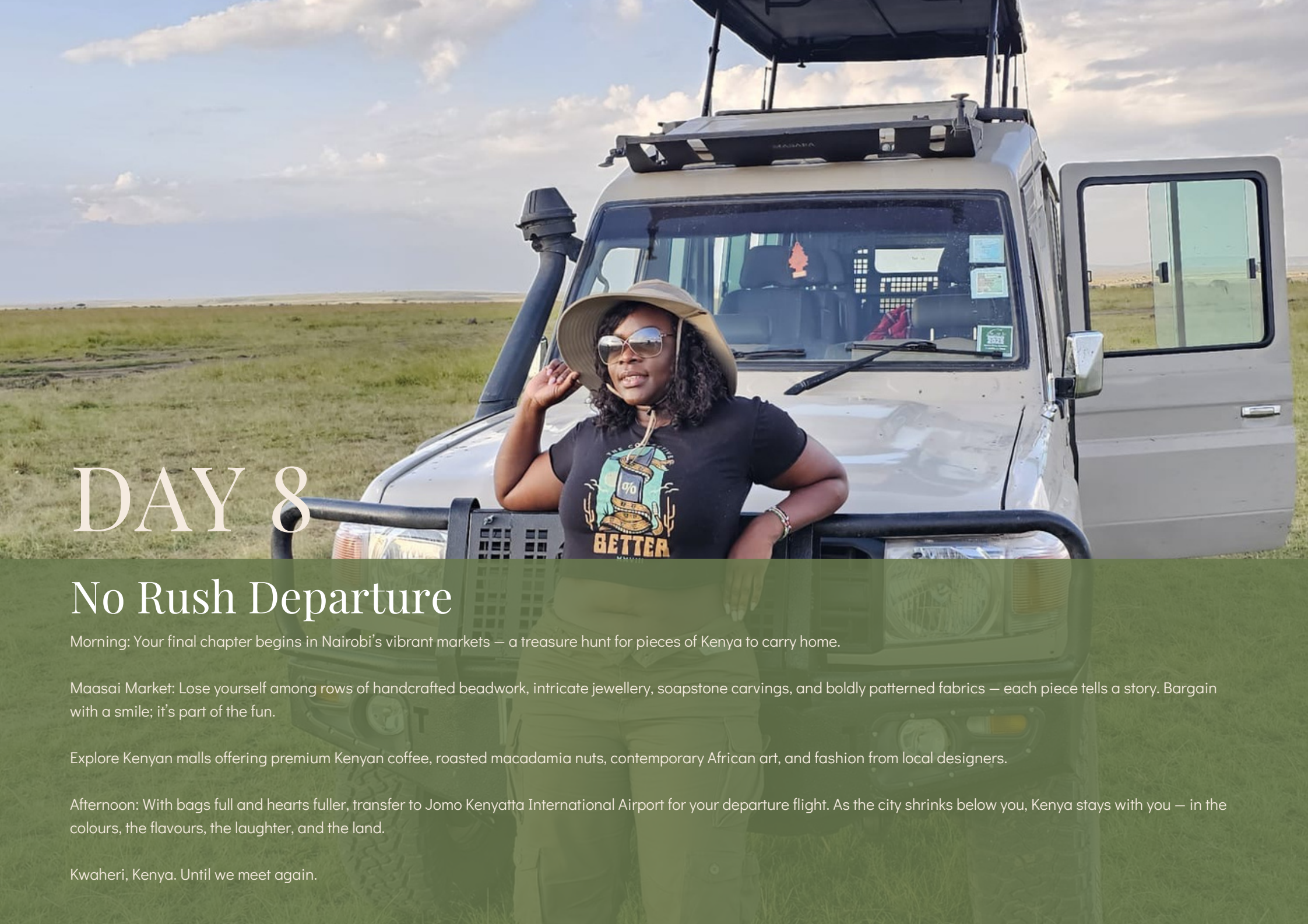
Return to Nairobi
